Course Description:

Trauma Informed Specialists (TIS) are professionals who understand how to support children who have experienced trauma and adapt the school environment to successfully meet their academic, socio-emotional and behavioral needs. In addition this certification ensures that the professional has built a strong foundation of self-care and awareness to limit the impact of vicarious trauma on their personal functioning and use this training to build trauma informed schools. 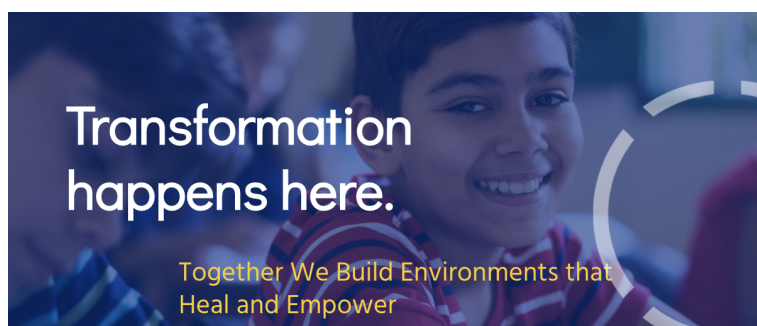
